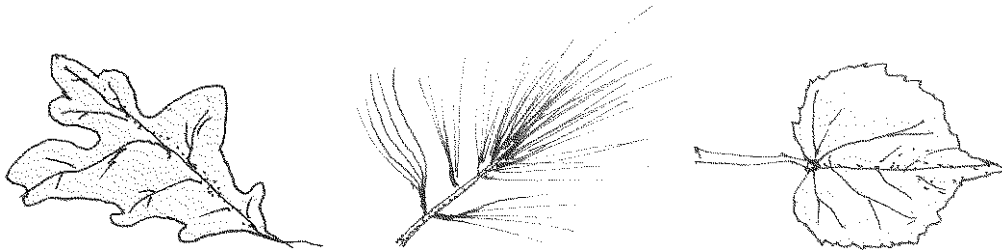
Garden Center Association Lake Tree Find Walk

To follow this walk, download the accompanying map. Each tree coordinates with a number on the map. This course begins at the Garden Center Building.

1. Weeping White Pine – *Pinus strobus* ‘Pendula’

Clue: Weeping branches, leaves that are long soft needles.

2. Black Walnut – *Juglans nigra*

Clue: Known for its edible fruit (nuts).

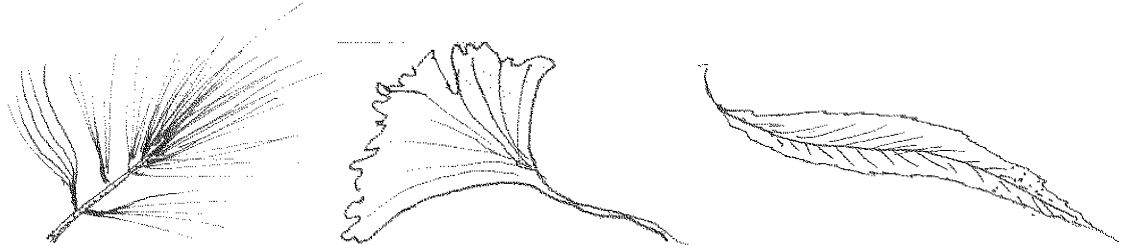
Which one does my leaf look like? (circle one)



3. Eastern White Pine – *Pinus strobus*

Clue: Leaves are long, soft needles that are 5 to a bundle.

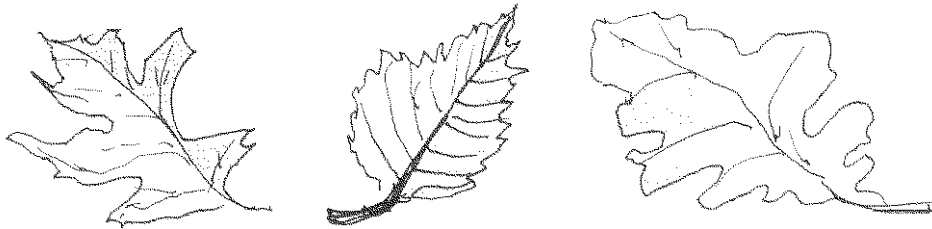
Which one does my leaf look like? (circle one)



4. River Birch – *Betula nigra*

Clue: Characterized by peeling bark.

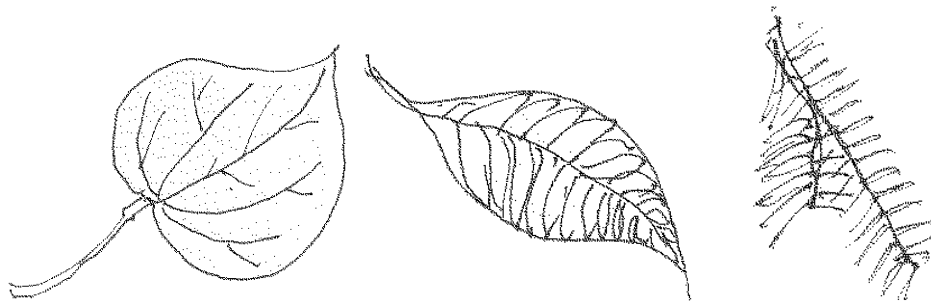
Which one does my leaf look like? (circle one)



5. Eastern Redbud – *Cercis Canadensis*

Clue: Heart shaped leaves.

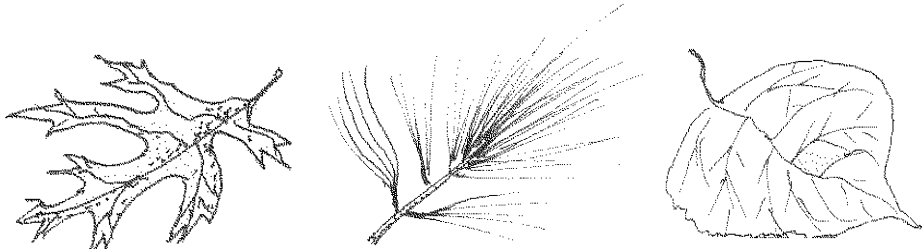
Which one does my leaf look like? (circle one)



6. Eastern White Pine – *Pinus strobes*

Clue: Leaves are long needles that are soft to the touch.

7. Weeping White Pine – *Pinus strobus* 'Pendula'

Clue: A dwarf form of number 1.

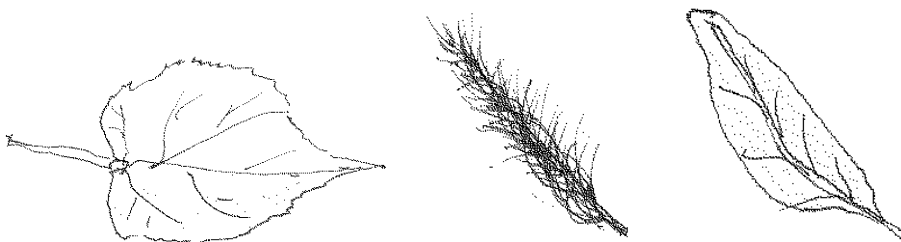
Which one does my leaf look like? (circle one)



8. Colorado Spruce – *Picea pungens*

Clue: Blue leaves are needles that spread around the stem, very prickly.

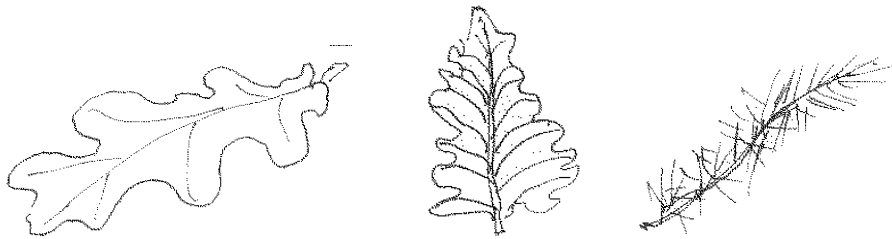
Which one does my leaf look like? (circle one)



9. English Oak – *Quercus robur*

Clue: A giant of a tree, broadly rounded, open-headed with a short trunk.

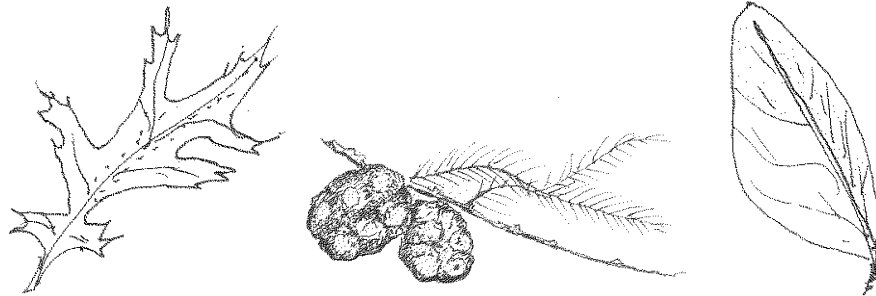
Which one does my leaf look like? (circle one)



10. Baldcypress – *Taxodium distichum*

Clue: Roots form “knees” above ground when planted near water.

Which one does my leaf look like? (circle one)



11. Weeping willow - *Salix 'babylonica'*

Clue: Rounded crown of weeping branches bend down to the ground.

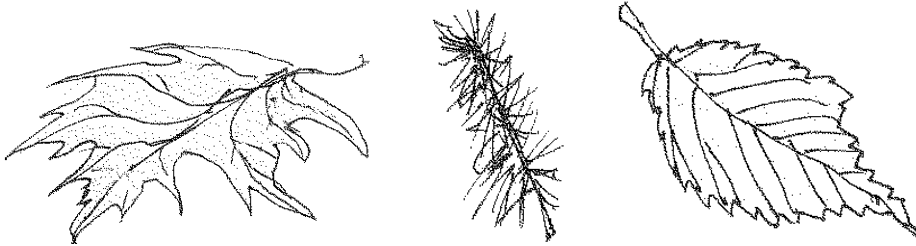
Which one does my leaf look like? (circle one)



12. Siberian Elm – *Ulmus pumila*

Clue: In poor condition with broken branches and many cankers.

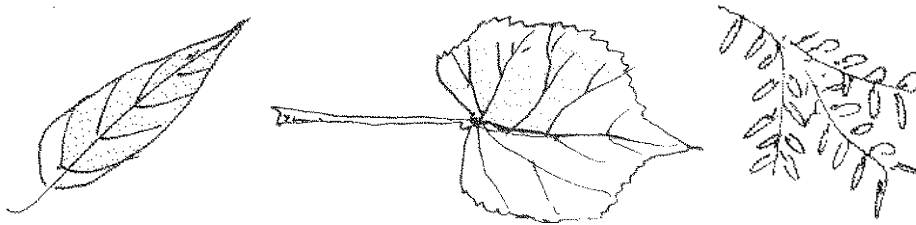
Which one does my leaf look like? (circle one)



13. Littleleaf Linden – *Tilia cordata*

Clue: Heart shaped leaves with yellowish fragrant flowers in June then globose, thin shelled nutlets covered with gray fuzz.

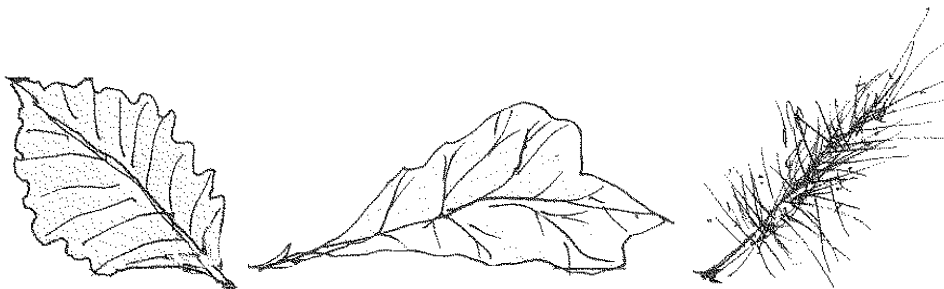
Which one does my leaf look like? (circle one)



14. Swamp Chestnut Oak – *Quercus michauxii*

Clue: There is a squirrel house in the branches of this Champion.

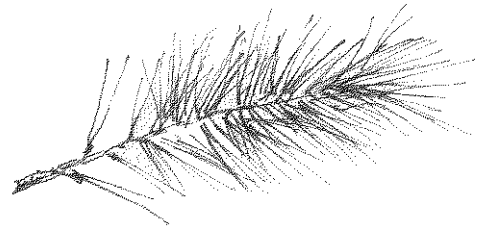
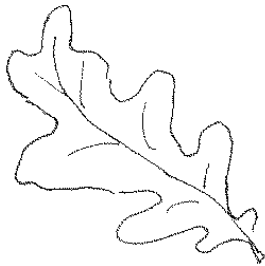
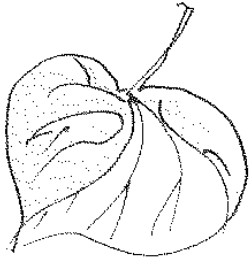
Which one does my leaf look like? (circle one)

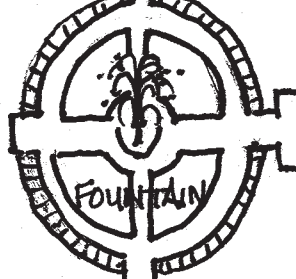

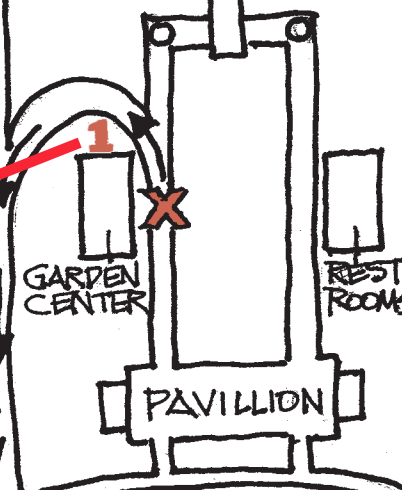
